Accommodation

We had to take some unpopular measures due to the combination of an increased number of Camp participants and financial hardships that engulfed the whole world.

1. **All Camp participants (mentors and schoolchildren will be accommodated in the school.** Mentors will be accommodated to one group bunk bed room and UNESCO centre in the attic. Schoolchildren will occupy two group bunk bed rooms and a gym. Therefore **all schoolchildren will have to be equipped with inflatable mattresses, sleeping bags, sheets and small pillows.**
2. If any of the mentors should prefer to have their lodgings at Panorama guest house, let us know by email prior to 3 September so that we can book them. **Price: 20 € per person per night, covered by mentors themselves.**
3. Arrival time and accommodation: **Sunday 18, from 17.00 to 20.00 hours.** Please mind the time, due to the technical preparations, the accommodation is not possible earlier than the time above.
Departures: **Friday 23 after the closing performance** or on Saturday 24 at the latest.
4. Please supply us with the **names of participating mentors and children.**
Deadline: September 3!

Performances

- Participating schools are kindly requested to prepare a short presentation of their delegation (1-2 mins max) to refresh the **opening ceremony** on Monday at 8.30. If it is done in your folk costumes, so much the better. The performances will be viewed by our pupils and teachers.
- Prepare a 3-minute performance for the **closing show** (suggested topics: kids with special needs, cultural and natural heritage, peace...). Folk costumes are desired. The closing show will be substantiated by your shows.
- **RaW's Peace Award** – each school is expected to prepare a short (2 mins) presentation of their personality who has in their view contributed to peace nationally or internationally.

- **Banquet** will take place on Sunday 18, at 20.00 hours in the school mess room.
Make it rich and tasty- present your country through your typical food.

Workshops

- **Workshops** – you are heartily requested to email us a short plan of the workshop that will be led by your mentor(s). Inform us about the ICT or other requirements that you will need. Workshops will last 2 hours.

The Camp time-table will be sent to you first days in September.
